Scholarship Program 2005

The Perennial Plant Association is proud to offer six scholarships to college students studying horticulture or a related subject area. Students enrolled in two- or four-year programs are eligible to apply. Each scholarship recipient will receive \$1000 and complimentary registration for all lectures and tours at the 2005 Perennial Plant Symposium in Knoxville, Tennessee, July 17-24. Recipients will also receive complimentary lodging during the symposium. Scholarship recipients must attend the symposium to receive the \$1000 scholarship. The completed application should be mailed to the PPA office by **March 1, 2005**. Each scholarship applicant will be notified by May 10, 2005.

REQUIREMENTS:

Student should be majoring or minoring in horticulture or a related field.
Student should have at least one quarter or semester remaining following spring 2005.
Student should have a minimum 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
Recipients must attend the 2005 Perennial Plant Symposium.
An interest in a career in perennials is preferred but not required.
Applications must be postmarked on or before March 1, 2005.

Statement of Purpose:

On a separate sheet of paper, state briefly why you wish to pursue a career in horticulture. Describe your career goals and how a scholarship will help you meet them. Include your interest and work with herbaceous perennials.

College Transcripts:

Please include a copy of your official college transcript.

Recommendation Letters:

Three letters of recommendation, including one from an academic advisor explaining your interest in horticulture and perennials, and one from a member of the Perennial Plant Association, should be included with the application form.
