The **Perennial Plant Association** is proud to offer five scholarships to college students studying horticulture or a related subject area. Students enrolled in two or four year programs are eligible to apply. Each scholarship recipient will receive \$1000 and complimentary registration for all lectures and tours at the 2010 Perennial Plant Symposium in Portland, Oregon, July 18-24. Recipients will also receive complimentary lodging during the symposium. Scholarship recipients are welcomed and encouraged to attend the entire symposium. However, each recipient must attend July 21 to 23 to be eligible for the \$1000 scholarship. Applicants should consider this requirement before applying. The completed application should be mailed to the PPA office by **March 1, 2010**. Each scholarship applicant will be notified by April 26, 2010.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Student should be majoring or minoring in horticulture or a related field.
- Student should have at least one quarter or semester remaining following spring term 2010.
- Student should have a minimum 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Recipients must be able to attend the 2010 Perennial Plant Symposium in Portland.
- An interest in a career in perennials is preferred but not required.
- Applications must be postmarked on or before March 1, 2010.
- Undergraduate students only are eligible to apply.
- Prior scholarship winners are not eligible to apply.

Statement of Purpose:

On a separate sheet of paper, state why you wish to pursue a career in horticulture. Describe your career goals and how a scholarship will help you meet them. Include your interest and work or study with herbaceous perennials.

College Transcripts:

Please include a copy of your official college transcript.

Recommendation Letters:

Three letters of recommendation, including one from an academic advisor explaining your interest in horticulture and perennials, and one from a member of the Perennial Plant Association, should be included with the application form.
